Metropolitan Ceramics' unglazed quarry tile is fired in tunnel kilns heated in temperatures exceeding 2,000°F, so it's low absorption, slip resisting and super durable compared to epoxy flooring.

Grout joints channel water away from the surface, adding slip resistance. And today's grout is superior to the past; when properly installed and maintained, it lasts for the life of the flooring.

- Risk delamination if not installed correctly.
- Can be slippery especially when wet or greasy.
- Can allow mold and bacteria growth in compromised flooring.
